



SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IN CAMBODIA

I. INTRODUCTION.

Increasing the scholastic achievement of girls is a challenge in much of the developing world. The research study show that the scholarship program has a large, positive effect on the school enrollment and attendance of girls. Scholarships give promising learner an opportunity to pursue their education regardless of their financial circumstances. In order to help learners, Kamboo Project is providing the budget to a female learner to continue with their schooling without worry about the budget to buy supplies for their study as well as



supporting their family to purchase food. In many rural areas of developing countries, the daughter is normally responsible for helping their father or mother to find food for their siblings.

II. ELIGIBLE LEARNERS:

1. Female Learners with a disability (physical impairment)
2. Female Learners who live with a single parent, either mother or father.
3. Female Learners who live in poor conditions with more than one brother and sister under her control (Parents are holders of an “ID Poor Card”)
4. Female Learners who live with grandparents due to parent divorces.
5. Female Learners who face dropping out of

school because they need to support themselves and their families financially.

III. PROJECT PLANNING:

We will work with 50 primary schools in the Prasat Bakong district, containing some of the country's most impoverished communities. Our project will work closely with the key stakeholders such as School Principal, the chief of the education department, village and commune heads, and other community representatives to select the eligible learners to receive a fund package.

Every Females learner will be visited and evaluated by our team to ensure that they are the right beneficiary and to make sure our fund strongly contributes, supports and motivates them to keep striving for a higher education and to become a valuable citizen for the country. The pictures, video recordings, and reports that will be produced will be sent to you after the learners have been provided with their scholarship fund.

IV. BUDGET

The project will distribute the fund every month by the Kamboo Project team, so we can also monitor the learner's monthly attendance. Target is 10 Scholarship packages for the year 2023. We target only female learners passing grade 6 and decided to stop their study in grade 7.
